Intervention Name	Number of pupils assigned	Amount allocated to this Intervention/action	Intended outcomes
1:1 Maths Tuition - In school	10 students in Year 11	£2,800	To narrow the attainment and progress gaps between PP and non PP students in Mathematics across the school.
Wey Ecademy	Year 11	£1,500	Using state of the art digital technology and engaging teaching methods to provide students with live lessons, homework assignments and after school clubs, Wey Ecademy aim to help remove the anxiety from learning, encouraging participation and interaction with other students. Covering a broad range of subjects, Wey Academy can reach out to students who are absent for a wide variety of reasons allowing them to learn, progress and reach their full potential.
Tute Science	48 students in year 11 across both subjects	£750	To use the power of technology to deliver teacher led lessons through online learning, providing more innovative and effective ways of engaging and enthusing our students.
Y6 Summer School	Year 6	£500	To benefit the transition process positively and improve numeracy and literacy.
Life Coaching	40 students mainly focusing on year 11 and 10.	£7,000	Students work with our Life Coach to set individual goals based on their specific needs, whether that be academic or personal issues.
Reading Catch-Up Programme	Year 7 - Year 9	£2,500	To aim to raise reading age, improve vocabulary and encourage reading in KS3. More training will also be provided for teachers on Accelerated Reader and Bedrock learning.
Trips and visits	All years	£3,000	To assist disadvantaged students with the help towards the cost of educational trips and visits outside of school.
Achievement Voucher	Year 7 & Year 10	£7,000	To help support students learning outside of school. To foster positive relationships with parents. This year we will be issuing vouchers to students in Year 10 as well, to help them prepare for KS4.

Attendance Interventions and Travel support	All years	£1,500	To help improve the attendance of students who have moved out of area due to a change in their home circumstances. Travel costs are also supported for students who attend college courses.
Extra Curricular and External Provisions (Such as Music lessons, Hair-tastic, Firebreak, Angling and Boxing)	All years	13,000	Supporting specific courses inside and outside of school, with targeted students, to enable them to mix in new friendships, build up confidence and self esteem and have the opportunity to take part in an activity which interests them.
Stationary, books laptops and computer software - new software to record our Pupil Premium Interventions	All years	£8,500	To ensure students have all the necessary equipment to feel confident and prepared for examinations/school day. This year, we will be purchasing new software to further assist our Pupil Premium team in tracking and assessing our students.
Counselling Sessions	All years	£16,500	Providing a therapeutic approach to help students explore and understand difficulties they may be having.
